SG-5	Burglary	The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony/theft	Elevated
SG-6	Larceny-Theft	The unlawful taking of property	Elevated
SG-7	Vehicle Theft	The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle	Elevated
